

# INTERMEDIATE LEVEL DRESSAGE TESTS

## U.S. EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION 2010 INTERMEDIATE EVENTING TEST B

**Conditions: 1) Bridle:** A plain snaffle bridle, made entirely of leather or leather like material, with either a regular cavesson, a dropped noseband, a flash noseband or crossed noseband. A double bridle with cavesson noseband, i.e. bit and bridoon with curb chain (made of metal or leather) is also permitted. For drawings of permitted bits and nosebands please see Appendix 4.

**2) Arena:** 20m x 60m (standard) **3) Time:** Approximately 5:00

13.	<b>F to M</b> Medium canter. <b>M</b> Collected canter.	Lengthening of frame and stride, straightness, transitions	<b>10</b>
14.	<b>C - A</b> Serpentine 3 loops quarter line.	Quality of canter, balance, bend and geometry of serpentine	<b>10</b>
15.	<b>PXS</b> Change rein. Simple change of lead between S and H	Straightness, quality of canter and walk Calmness of transitions	<b>10</b>
16.	<b>M - F</b> Medium canter. <b>F</b> Collected canter.	Lengthening of frame and stride, straightness, transitions	<b>10</b>

Leave arena free walk on a long rein at A. All trot work performed sitting unless stated otherwise.

<b>Impulsion</b>	Desire to move forward. Elasticity of the steps. Suppleness of the back and engagement of the hind quarters	<b>10</b>
<b>Submission</b>	Acceptance of the bridle. Attention and confidence. Harmony. Lightness of the forehand. Ease of movements.	<b>10</b>
<b>Rider</b>	Position and seat. Correctness and effect of the aids.	<b>10</b>
