June Board Meeting
June 26, 2008, Goochland Library

- Meeting opened by President Hollyn Mangione, with Gina Sybert, Pat Albertson, Megan Proffitt and Kelly Yeong present; Pat Martin was also present by telephone.
- Discussion opened regarding an email from Laurie McIntire about the status of the monthly newsletter. Her e-mail made several very valid points including the fact that it seemed unnecessary to have monthly newsletters with the constantly updated website. Pat Albertson made a motion to remove the newsletter position from the board and transition to a weekly email update from the President. Megan Proffitt seconded the motion. A quorum was present and voted to discontinue the newsletter and eliminate the Newsletter Editor position from the board. The board had not originally included a ninth member or a Newsletter Editor position; therefore, it seemed logical to discontinue this position.
- By-laws are in the works.
- Jocelyn Kriss clinic was a successful, safe, fun, learning experience. The clinic produced a net profit of \$10.00. This was good considering that the intent of the clinic fee was to just cover the cost of the clinic.
- Dates for upcoming shows were discussed. Megan Holt and Elizabeth Schooley will be informed of this information so that they can begin to organize for the shows.
- Tuckahoe Plantation was discussed as a possible location for a Mix and Match show in September. This format allows riders to choose which dressage tests and which jumping height they would prefer to combine with prizes for 1-8 place in Junior and Adult divisions. Possible pricing strategy: CT - \$40, add a dressage test - \$25, add jump - \$15
- Aria Farm was discussed as a possible location for a combined test on October 11, 2008.
- Penmerryl Farm Trip has been confirmed for Friday, October 17, 2008 through Sunday, October 19, 2008. – Payment for Debbie Rodriguez to be \$560 for 6 hour of instruction + food, lodging and lessons. Cost per person will be \$250. This price includes two nights lodging and stabling plus three one-hour group lessons (one dressage, one cross country, and one stadium).
